Introduction:

In the next following steps, we will explain how to create API token for Agheera into mobileWEB application.

Step 1:

User login to mobileWEB application <https://mobileweb.cvs-mobile.com>

IMPORTANT!!! Only users who are owners or admin users can edit this function.

Step 2:

After successful login, user first create group of vehicles. This step must be done if they only need to display certain group of vehicles. If all vehicles need to be displayed there's no need to create separate group of vehicles

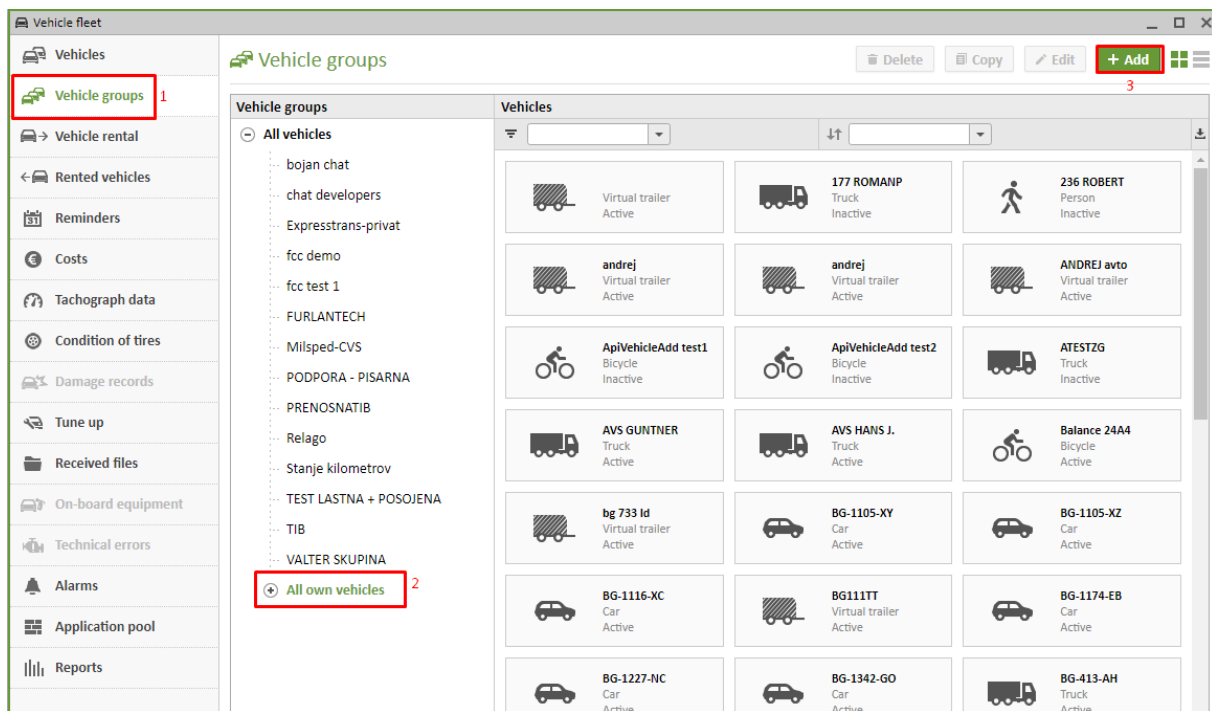
Select icon of car (Vehicle fleet)



New window opens

Here user selects

- Vehicle groups(1) then goes under
- All own vehicles(2) and
- + Add(3)

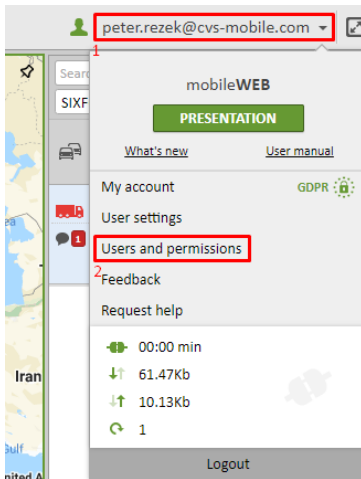

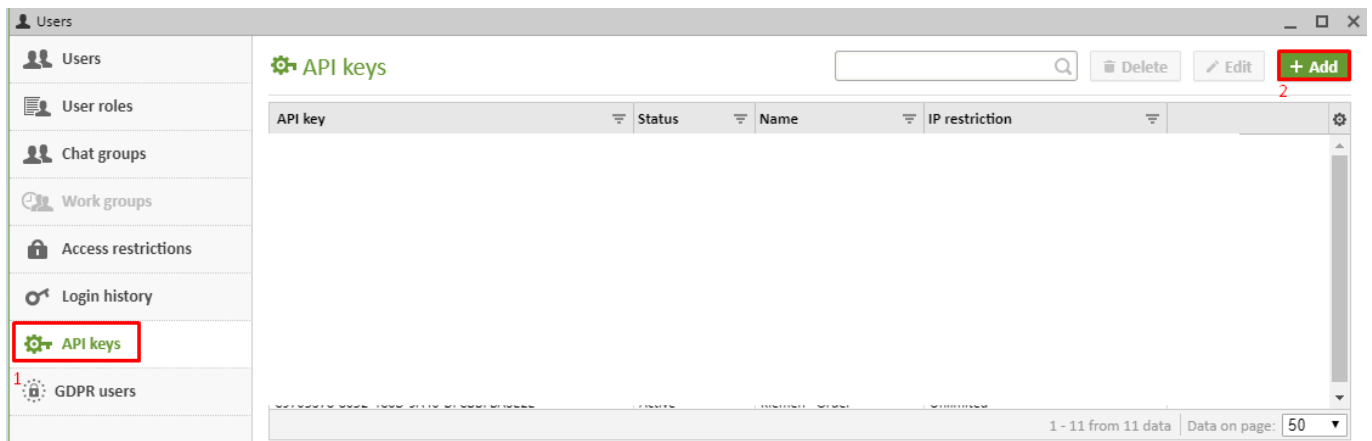
